Medical Evaluation for Seasonal Work Visa – USA

In compliance with your pre-departure requirements and in order to obtain the seasonal work visa, you are to undergo a medical evaluation. For this purpose, Workaway International has contracted with MMI Holdings whose selected doctors have been specifically briefed with the requirements necessary to obtain medical clearance for health screening purposes.

- Visit the pathologist as allocated in the cover sheet
- Take your ID together with the pathology referral letter and cover sheet
- A blood test will be done to screen for active Hepatitis A, B and C

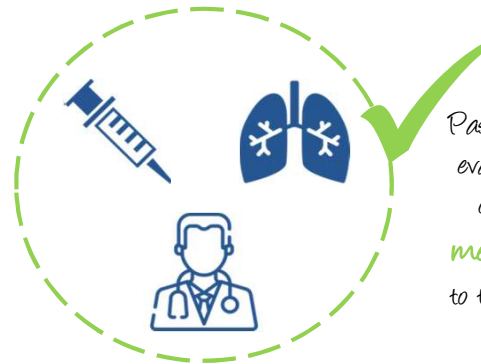
- Visit the radiologist as allocated in the cover sheet
- Take your ID together with the radiology referral letter and cover sheet
- A chest x-ray will be done to screen for active Tuberculosis



Visits to the pathologist and radiologist must be done at least three (3) days before your visit to the doctor

3

- Visit the doctor as allocated in the cover sheet
- Take your ID together with your radiology report, x-ray of your chest, drug/ pregnancy test (females) and the six (6) page medical evaluation booklet (for doctor use only)
- After the evaluation you may leave, taking your ID with you
- Leave the medical evaluation booklet with the doctor



Passing all three evaluations will certify you **medically fit** to travel & work abroad!!!



- ✓ All medical evaluations must be completed by the specified dates
- ✓ Refrain from taking any pain medication and vitamins at least 72 hours prior to your tests
- ✓ Notify the doctor if you are taking any antibiotic or other medication to treat an existing condition
- ✓ Re-tests done at the allocated providers will be for your own account
- ✓ If urine tests are positive for protein or blood, a re-test can be done at your local Dischem/ Clicks pharmacy
- ✓ If any of your Hepatitis A, B or C results are positive, immediately request for an immunity test at the allocated provider, which will be for your own account

Please follow the mentioned procedures carefully to avoid any delay in the processing of your application
